Angus Alcohol and Drugs Partnership Digital Lifelines

What is the purpose of the scheme?

To provide people experiencing problems with drug or alcohol use with the devices and digital means to access the Digital Lifelines Project and other online supports that may assist them in their recovery process.

Who can apply?

Any organisation that is working with people affected by alcohol and drug use.

How many devices can I apply for?

You can apply for one device and one mobile wifi device for each individual. Should further wifi devices be required this can be discussed with the ADP Support Team.

What are the criteria for requests?

- Applications must relate to individuals receiving support relating to their drug and/or alcohol use.
- The application must relate to individuals living in Angus.
- Applications must be made by an organisation. Applications directly from individuals will not be considered.
- Baseline Questionnaires will be required before and throughout support and at the end of the funded programme for quality and improvement and reporting purposes.

Can I apply more than once for the same person?

Unless the initial device provided is faulty, only one device will be supplied per individual. It is the responsibility of the individual to make use of the Digital Lifelines project and other online resources that may support their recovery. The device will remain the property of the individual once the programme has been completed to enable them to continue to access online supports.

When do I apply?

Applications can be submitted at any time and will be considered as soon as possible after they are received. We will try to respond within the same working day wherever possible.
